- **Virtual Training**: students have free access to salary negotiation and financial literacy webinars and workshops, leadership training resources, research publications, and more.
- A Community of Activists: AAUW members are provided access to tools, resources and training
 they need to advocate for gender equity issues and make their voices heard in Congress, at the
 statehouse, and in the ballot box.
- National Conference for Students: AAUW has an annual conference the National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL) in Washington, D.C. They offer scholarships to attend.
- **Community Action Grants**: College students can apply for a Community Action Grant of up to \$5000 to complete a community project.
- **Scholarship programs**: Annually, the AAUW Roseville-South Placer Branch grants several AAUW Sierra College Re-entry Scholarships to women restarting their education.
